We are looking for a theatre facilitator to lead our programme of workshops with our partner primary school, who we have been running weekly sessions with for Years 1-6 since 2018.

The workshop plans are developed collaboratively with the school, leading to an end of term performance.

We are looking for a facilitator who is passionate about using theatre to help young people build confidence, creativity and teamworking skills as well as reinforcing elements of the curriculum.

- Training and / or equivalent experience in different kinds of facilitation techniques

- Excellent time management skills and attention to detail
- Knowledge and experience of working with Child Protection and/or Safeguarding policies and procedures
- A fully enhanced DBS
